

## ROCKTOBERFEST COUNTRY-OKE CONTEST

***NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCE OF WINNING. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.***

### 1. HOW TO ENTER

a. The Rocktoberfest Country-Oke Contest (the "Contest") will begin on Thursday, June 25, 2009 at 5:30 pm Pacific Time ("PT") and end at approximately 10:00 pm PT, Saturday, October 24, 2009.

b. To participate in the contest, you may enter via the following method:

**REGISTER:** Listeners must come to Snoqualmie Casino, 37500 SE North Bend Way, Snoqualmie WA 98065 beginning at 5:30 pm PT on June 25, 2009 and complete an official entry form including their first and last name of competitor as well as the complete address, city, state, zip code, email address, home telephone number and date of birth of each of entrant of the Contest. All entries must be completed and submitted to staff by 7:00 pm PT on each night the event takes place. At the time each completed entry is submitted to the staff, that entrant will receive a number based on the order they submit their entry. The Contest will take place Every Thursday from June 18, 2009 – October 22, 2009 at Snoqualmie Casino.

**PERFORM:** Beginning at 6:00 PM PT on June 25, 2009, each competitor will be chosen randomly from all eligible entries received at that time, and will perform one (1) song onstage. Each contestant will have only one opportunity to perform each night of the competition. Contestant must perform a known country song, no original music is allowed, from the song list provided by Rockaraoke. Contestants will not be allowed to perform with acoustic instruments and will be backed by a live band.

Contestants are not allowed to have substitute or additional musician(s) and singer(s) during their performance. All songs will be in their original key and original arrangement. The song key and arrangement will not be changed to suite contestant's vocal styling or range. All lyrics will be available on a flat screen monitor located on stage. Lyrics are currently only available in English.

c. Limit one entry per person.

d. KMPS/GAD Entertainment/Snoqualmie Casino are not responsible for lost, stolen, mangled, mis-delivered, illegible, incomplete or late entries.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY RESTRICTIONS

a. The contest is open to anyone 21 years of age or older. Employees of Snoqualmie Casino, GAD Entertainment and KMPS are ineligible to participate or win.

b. Participants must sign a CBS Radio participant release and a CBS Radio video release authorizing the videotape of the performance and unlimited use of the video.

### 3. PRIZES

a. One (1) Grand Prize will be awarded. The Grand Prize consists of \$ an opportunity to perform their winning song as the opener for a show TBD at the Snoqualmie Casino on December 12, 2009 and \$2,500 in cash. Total estimated value: \$2,500.00. There is no guarantee that the winner will be able to perform on December 12, 2009; this decision will be made in the sole and absolute discretion of the show producers.

b. Secondary prizes will be awarded as follows: 2<sup>nd</sup> Place \$1,000; 3<sup>rd</sup> Place \$600; 4<sup>th</sup> Place \$500; 5<sup>th</sup> Place \$250; 6<sup>th</sup> Place \$100; 7<sup>th</sup> Place \$50.

c. There is no substitution, transfer, or cash equivalent for prizes, except that Sponsor may, at its sole discretion, substitute prizes of comparable value or cash. The prizes are expressly limited to the item(s) listed above and do not include taxes, gratuities or any other expenses. Other restrictions may apply.

#### 4. WINNER SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION

a. Decisions of the management with respect to the contest are final.

b. At each Contest date, all audience members will receive a voting ballot at the time they enter the Snoqualmie Casino. Following the performances each Thursday Contest date, audience members will vote for their favorite performer by writing their number on a ballot. All voting will take place at 7:50 PM PT and all ballots must be submitted to staff by 8:00 PM PT each Thursday. Votes will be collected and counted on site by staff.

c. Each performance will be voted on by audience members. Each attendee will choose their favorite performer and write their number on a ballot. The contestant with the highest total votes will be declared the winner each week. In the event of a tie, there will be a second round of voting by audience members on all tied performers.

d. Each Thursday Contest date, one (1) Finalist will be selected. Each Contest date, one (1) Finalist will be selected as stated in section 4.b. and 4.c. of these contest rules.

e. The final judging of all Finalists will begin on Saturday, October 24 at 7:00 PM PT. Each Finalist will perform one song with the band and will be judged by a selection of judges (at least 5 but no more than 11).

f. Contestants must be present to win. Grand Prize winner must be present to win.

g. Winners must execute and return any required Affidavit of Eligibility/Release of Liability Prize Acceptance Form onsite or prize will be forfeited and an alternate winner may be chosen based on the contestant with the second highest point total. If the winners cannot perform on dates determined by management in its sole discretion then they will automatically forfeit the prize and the second runner up will be notified.

h. Limit one preliminary qualification per performer.

#### 5. CONDITIONS

a. Payments of all federal, state and local taxes are solely the responsibility of the winners. Winners will be required to complete and submit an IRS Form W-9 with the winner's full Social Security Number or the equivalent for receipt of any prize valued at \$600 or more or for any prizes awarded by the Station in a calendar year with an aggregate value of \$600 or more. Failure to submit a complete W-9 or equivalent will result in forfeiture of the prize.

b. By participating in the Contest, the winner or winners agree to have their name, voice, or likeness used in any advertising or broadcasting material relating to this Contest without additional financial or other compensation, and, where legal, to sign a publicity release confirming such consent prior to acceptance of the prize.

c. Prior to awarding any prize or prize certificate, management, in its sole discretion, may require Contest winners (and their travel companions, if any) to sign a liability release, agreeing to hold management, its corporate licensee, its parent, subsidiary and affiliated corporations, and the officers, shareholders, directors, employees, agents and representatives of each of them harmless against any and all claims or liability arising directly or indirectly from the prize or participation in the Contest.

d. Management reserves the right to make changes in the rules of the Contest, including the substitution of a prize of equivalent value, which will become effective upon announcement. If due to circumstances beyond the

control of management, any competition or prize-related event is delayed, rescheduled, postponed or cancelled, management reserves the right, but not the obligation, to cancel or modify the Contest and shall not be required to award a substitute prize.

e. Failure to comply with the Contest rules may result in a contestant's disqualification solely at the discretion of management.

f. Management is not responsible for typographical or other errors in the printing, the offering or the administration of the Contest, or in the announcement of a prize.
